

Vanpooling is a convenient and popular way to get to work, especially for people who work far from home. "Official" vanpools consist of seven to 15 passengers, including the driver. The van used for the vanpool may be owned by one of the vanpoolers or leased from a vanpool rental company. There are approximately 80 independently-operated vanpools in the Bay Area registered with 511.org.

511 Contra Costa Vanpool Incentive Program

511 Contra Costa provides half of the costs for the first three months of joining. Drivers who start new vanpools and keep them on the road for at least a year will receive a \$1,000 bonus.
