

511 Contra Costa consists of three regional offices that develop and administer projects and programs on behalf of the 20 Contra Costa jurisdictions, with direction from the four Regional Transportation Planning Committees.

These projects and programs encourage motorists who currently drive alone to work or college to try an alternative commute mode instead. 511 Contra Costa works with city and county staff, elected officials, employers, commuters and residents throughout the county to develop these programs.

Funding is provided primarily by the Contra Costa Transportation Authority's half-cent transportation sales tax measure, the Metropolitan Transportation Commission and the Bay Area Air Quality Management District's Transportation Fund for Clean Air.
