- Incentive programs to entice motorists to try alternatives
- Bicycle safety training classes



## **COMMUTER INCENTIVE PROGRAM**

### **Vanpool Driver Bonus**

Organize a new van, fill it with at least six passengers, keep it on the road for at least one year and the driver could be eligible for a \$1,000 cash bonus.

### **Guaranteed Ride Home**

511 Contra Costa knows a good back-up plan is needed for commuters who don't drive their car to work. The leading reason commuters state for driving alone to work is the need to get home in the case of an emergency or a sudden change to the work schedule. The Countywide Guaranteed Ride Home Program provides a free taxi ride home (to commuters who work in Contra Costa and who use a commute alternative) in the case of an emergency or un-planned change to the work schedule. Pre-registration is required.
