

The maps on the following pages depict two types of potential mass transit travel options. The **Bay Area Transit Service Providers** map illustrates how to travel the entire San Francisco Bay Area using public transit. The transit service operators are indicated by the colored lines on the map. Look to see which ones you would need to travel from your origin to your destination.

The **Contra Costa Transit Routes and Service Area** map depicts local mass transit routes and service areas. The lightly colored “sheds” show the transit service areas for a particular city. This helps if you know what city you are in or need to travel to but you don’t know the name of the bus or train that serves the area. The map also illustrates the weekday commuter express bus routes.

Both maps show where the major **Transit Transfer Stations** are located. Transit Transfer Stations are hubs where many transit lines come together to maximize transfers from one transit line to another.
