Pre-Tax Commuter Benefits

The federal tax code allows employers to provide to employees a *Qualified Transportation Fringe Benefit*. These benefits can be deducted from an employee's pre-tax income for qualified expenses such as public transit, vanpool, cycling and commuter-related parking. Currently, the maximum is \$125 per month for public transit and vanpool expenses and \$240 per month for qualified parking expenses. Qualified bicycling expenses are allowed up to \$20 per month.
