VEHICLE PARKING

Most ACE and Amtrak stations offer limited free parking.

Only Caltrain stations south of San Jose Diridon (including Belmont) offer limited free parking. Generally, Caltrain stations offer parking for a fee. Daily parking fees are paid by validating the parking stall number in the ticket vending machine. Monthly parking permits can be obtained in conjunction with a multi-ride pass/ticket loaded onto Clipper®.

BICYCLE PARKING

Bike Lockers

Keyed and electronic lockers are available on a first come first serve basis at select stations. Keyed lockers require a rental agreement and/or may charge a monthly rental fee. On-demand electronic lockers require a BikeLink™ smart card to access self-service parking for a nominal hourly fee. Contact the agency for locker availability.

Secure Parking

Attended bike parking facilities are located at the Palo Alto and San Francisco Caltrain stations. Shared access bike storage sheds require a rental agreement and/or may charge a monthly rental fee. These sheds are located at the Menlo Park, Mountain View and Palo Alto Caltrain stations. Contact the agency for additional information.
